

Meeting Minutes

Summary of January Meeting

SCCA, JANUARY 9, 2013

- Pat Davidson called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- Members present: Peggy Rist, Fran Moxley,

- Marvin Marty installed the officers for 2013, Alex Couladis was not present.
- Minutes from December meeting were circulated and reviewed. Malcolm moved that the minutes be approved, Norman gave a second, minutes stand as presented.
- Pat read the treasurer's report. The checking account balance as of 12/31/12 was \$33,992.89 which includes the \$8000.00 grant from the Sisters of St. Joseph to be used for the playground.
- Fran reported that she would be sending thank you notes to the Sisters of St. Joseph and requested receipts for donations for tax reporting purposes.
- Peggy Rist presented the calendar for January.

 There had been some inquiry about the possibility of Zumba classes being held at the Center.
- Gail and Jerry updated the membership about the storage room, sewing room and men's restroom renovations. The cost of the sprayer wand in the dish washing area is estimated at \$400.00. Peggy Rist made a motion that we move forward with the purchase, Walter seconded, the motion carried. Other maintenance issues include a leak in the boiler room, the regulator a 3" pipe, being the

- main line. Rhonda moved that the repairs be made, Norman seconded, motion carried. Also discussed was the bladder in the water tank that has gone bad. It will be replaced in the near future. Also, to be repaired is the picture of the class of 1964 that hangs in the hallway.
- Gail said that the History group would meet 1/15/13, the topic of discussion yet to be determined.

 They will also meet every Wednesday at 10:00 to sort items in the history rooms.
- Karen and Walter reported that the Senior group had a dinner out at Gigi's in The Plains, the food was wonderful! Seniors will hold a soup supper March 9, 2013, and help with the community meal March 16.
- Pat and Steve met with Lodi Trustees; their approval was given to move forward with the playground. They discussed the status of the easement money from Verizon that was donated in 2005 in the amount of \$5000. This money was given in part to the Fire Dept, the balance to be determined at their February meeting. It is believed that the Fire Department will release their portion to the Community Center to help with the cost of the playground.
- Rosebud Home School group voted to use a different facility. We may hear from them again in March, when the trial period is expired.
- Norman was able to replace the microphone at a reasonable cost to the center, by means of Gary Dunfee. The retail cost was \$480.00, Gary reduced it to \$260, Norman donated \$110.00 toward the price, final cost to the center \$150.00.
- Valentine dinner will be February 16, 2013 at 6:00. Fran will order food, as well as a dozen each water pitchers and carafes from Gordon Food Service.
- Peggy Grueser moved that the meeting be adjourned, Malcolm seconded it, motion carried.

Summary of February Meeting

SCCA FEBRUARY 13, 2013

- Meeting called to order by President, Pat Davidson. Members present: Fran Moxley, Norman Shaner, Robin Krivesti, Grace Dorst, Rhonda Meeks, Roberta Henderson, Glenna Grim, Richard Grim, Heidi LaJohn Marty, Marvin Marty, Jerry Foster, Alex Couladis, Pat Davidson, Debbie McAdoo
- The minutes from the January meeting were circulated and reviewed. Norm moved that the minutes be accepted as reported; Alex seconded the motion, all in favor, the motion carried.
- Alex reported that we are currently showing \$40,516.91 in the bank, with \$20,000+ earmarked for the playground equipment and installation. This includes money the Fire Department released to the SCCA, their portion of the Verizon easement money, (initially \$2500.00 invested and drawn interest since 2005), a total of \$3022.00, as well as \$2500.00 that the Lodi Trustees presented (for investment and upgrade of the property).
- Fran reported that we currently have 139 members. She is working to get welcome cards out to new members as well as thank you cards to those who have shown support to the Center.

Maintenance committee reports

- that a new sprayer has been installed in the dishwashing area, coming in under cost at \$270.00. Additional repairs need to be done to the dishwasher soon. Jerry has worked a quick fix, the hope is that it will function adequately through Valentine's dinner, and then be repaired properly. The regulator valve in the boiler room has also been repaired, again under cost. Repairs were estimated at about \$500.00, but we were able to get parts for \$320.00. The storage room near the men's bathroom is finished, freeing up space in the sewing room. It was agreed that new shovels need to be purchased for snow removal. Pat will see to this.
- Peggy presented the calendar for February and March. Additions and corrections were made as needed. Tai chi will no longer be offered due to lack of participation. Peggy's contact number for reserving space is now 740-590-8661.
- It is possible that the Rosebud educational co-op has renewed interest in renting space from the Center. We will know more about this by the March meeting.
- Robin Krivesti helped us make connection with students from OU that are interested in assisting us in setting up a website for the SCCA/SSCA. Pat

- and Gail are supplying them with information. It is hoped that we can have a site up and running by the end of the current school term.
- Naming a committee for financial review for the Center was discussed. It was proposed that Marvin Marty, Teresa Winning, and Walter/Karen Jones sit on the review board.

 Marvin has agreed, Pat will contact those that were not in attendance, asking for their assistance.
- Robin reported that the Easter egg hunt will be March 24th at 1:00 p.m. Volunteers needed.
- Lost in Lodi Enduro Run will be April 7, with a spaghetti dinner the 6th. The Center agreed to prepare the meal.
- Pat announced that the insurance premium for the next year has gone up. She feels that a meeting with the agent and representatives from the Center is in order to discuss recently completed and upcoming projects, making sure we are adequately covered.
- Valentine dinner 2/16/13, 6:00 pm, volunteers needed, requesting help from Rhonda's 4-H club.
- Rhonda asked that all news items for the upcoming newsletter be turned in to her by 2/18/13.


