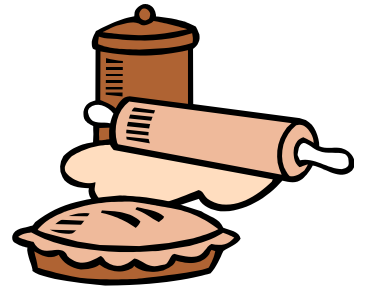

Contest Rules

1. **ENTRY IS FREE** and contest is open to men, women, children of all ages.
2. Pie crust and filling must be homemade. No commercially frozen crust or filling may be used.
3. **ALL PIES MUST BE DOUBLE-CRUST FRUIT PIES.** Lattice top pies are okay, but no pies that require refrigeration are eligible. In other words, no custard, cream, nor meringue pies will be judged.
4. Rhubarb is accepted as a fruit for this contest.
5. Pies **MUST** be made in 9-inch non-returnable aluminum pans.
6. Pies are to be at room temperature. Warm pies will not be judged.
7. Entries are limited to two per person, and each must be a different type of fruit pie.
8. Each entry requires a separate entry form.
9. Entries must be received by 10:00 am on the day of the festival.
10. Judging will begin at 10:30 am.
11. **ENTERED PIES BECOME THE PROPERTY OF THE JERSEYVILLE FESTIVAL.** Neither your pie nor your pie pan will be returned. Following the contest, prize winning pies may be auctioned. All other pies will be sold as individual slices.
12. By entering this contest, you give your permission to have your photo taken for promotional opportunities such as newsletter photographs.
